


Embedded

Tools Required: (unit ships fully assembled)

- For embedded: 3" dia drill for masonry
- For embedded: anchoring cement
- masonry drill and bits
- compressed air for clearing holes of debris




Recommended spacing, according to Association of Pedestrian and Bicycle Professionals (APBP)

ASSEMBLE WITH CARE! Pangard II® Polyester Powdercoat is a strong, long-lasting finish. To protect this finish during assembly, place unwrapped powdercoated parts on packaging foam or other non-marring surface. Do not place or slide powdercoated parts on concrete or other hard or textured surface – this will damage the finish causing rust to occur. Use touch-up paint on any gouges in the finish caused by assembly tools.

EMBEDDED INSTALLATION

- 1. Core drill 3" diameter (minimum) holes 6" deep.
- 2. Prepare the holes for outdoor anchoring cement.
- Follow the manufacturer's instructions for blowing out dust, filling with water, scrubbing, and removing excess water.
- Place the bike rack back into position and fill the holes with anchoring cement.
